#### **Position Details**

- 4. Photographer / Videographer to capture the essence of the event.
- 5. Rapporteurs take detailed notes of all sessions, summarize discussions, records action points, and compiles session reports for documentation and dissemination.
- 6. Master of ceremonies will guide the flow of the event, introduce speakers, moderate panel discussions, keep time, and maintain energy throughout the sessions.
